What is the Supermarket Scrip Program?

The Supermarket Scrip program is made available by area supermarkets that allow synagogue members the ability to purchase "Gift Cards" in various denominations. The "Gift Cards" are used just like cash, paid for at the synagogue but used in various grocery stores for purchases.

Does it cost me anything extra?

No - When you write a check to the Nanuet Hebrew Center for \$100.00 worth of Gift Cards - you get \$100.00 worth of Gift Cards.

How do I use the Gift Cards?

When you go to pay for your purchases at the supermarket, simply use the gift card rather than paying by check, cash or credit card. The value of your purchase is deducted from your card until there is no value left on the card. The card is used just like cash.

How does this benefit the synagogue?

The supermarkets provide a kick back of 5% of gift card purchases. As an example - if you purchase \$300.00 worth of gift cards, you get \$300.00 and the synagogue gets \$15.00

Can I pay for gift cards with my credit card?

No.

How will you deliver the gift card to me?

You can pick up your gift card in the shul office during business hours or by working with our office staff to determine the best way to get them into your hands.

Can individuals who are not members of the synagogue take advantage of this program?

Absolutely - and we encourage you to promote this program to your friends and family.
