



Congregation Shir Shalom COVID Reopening Committee Update:

The Congregation Shir Shalom Health & Safety / COVID Reopening Committee met on Sunday, March 6, 2022, to review the current protocols and determine new protocols based on current data. The following has been established as our updated COVID policy:

- For any event occurring in the building, unvaccinated individuals must continue to wear a mask. For individuals who are vaccinated, at least the first two shots, wearing a mask will be optional.
- For those Makom students who are vaccinated, wearing a mask is optional. Those students who are unvaccinated must continue to wear a mask.
- Out of courtesy and respect to others, those individuals serving as Shamash will continue to wear a mask during Shabbat services.
- Kiddushim will restart as soon as the Catering Committee can work out the logistics. We are hoping within the month; however, it could be delayed until after Passover.

We appreciate everyone's patience through this difficult time, and we thank you for your understanding.
